



Check VESA Pattern Compatibility

Attach the TV Brackets to Your TV

1-1 Select TV Bolts






1-3 Secure the TV Brackets


A WARNING:

- DO NOT turn the bolt past the bottom of the hole.
- If the bolt is too short, it may not adequately support the TV.
- If the bolt is too long, it could damage the TV.
- At least 4-5 turns into the threading is required.
- The depth of the bottom holes may be different from the top holes.




Too Short Too Long







You can use a tape measure to measure the protruding bolts or hold spacers next to them to choose the right spacer combination.







STEP 2 Connect the Support Pillar to the Base










STEP 3 Secure the TV Plate to the Support Pillar








STEP 4 Secure the Base to the Wooden Table










M6 x 12mm Bolt

STEP 5 Hang the TV on the TV Plate








Note: Hang the TV on the center of the TV plate.

STEP 7 Swivel Adjustment



The TV can be swiveled left or right. Only swivel the TV by the TV edges. Do not press on the screen.
